



Installation Manual

1 Upload the Mobile Melody files

Upload the enclosed `/mobile` folder to your existing PHP Melody installation, next to other folders such as: `/include`, `/admin`, etc.

Mac OSX users should make sure the `.htaccess` file is visible and uploaded as well. Under Mac OS, files beginning with a dot are hidden by default.

2 Enjoy

Starting with PHP Melody v2.0, there are no additional steps required.

PHP Melody will automatically detect and install the mobile plugin.

Grab your smartphone or tablet and type in your site's address. You will be redirected to your new mobile site *powered by* Mobile Melody.

How to manually install Mobile Melody

Instructions for PHP Melody sites running versions earlier than v2.0

Open PHP Melody's `/config.php` file.

Find the following line at the end of `/config.php`:

```
?>
```

Before this, add:

```
define('_URL_MOBI', _URL .'/mobile');

define('ABSPATH_MOBI', ABSPATH .'mobile/');

if (file_exists(ABSPATH_MOBI) && ! defined('IGNORE_MOBILE') &&
    strpos($_SERVER['SCRIPT_NAME'], '/admin/') === false)

{

define('MOBILE_MELODY', true);

include(ABSPATH_MOBI .'mobile_detect.php');

$mobile_detector = new Mobile_Detect;

define('USER_DEVICE', ($mobile_detector->isMobile()) ? 'mobile' : 'desktop');

include(ABSPATH_MOBI .'detect.php');

} else {

define('MOBILE_MELODY', false);  define('USER_DEVICE', 'desktop');

}
```

Save and upload the `/config.php` file.

That's it. Job well done!
